Ryleigh (year 10) started with us with a baseline assessment of Entry Level for Maths and English. After identifying areas of development and providing her with extra support he has now completed and passed Level 1 English and Level 1 Maths. Now working towards level 2 this year.

Attendance

Layton started at Educ8 with a school attendance of 10%. He engaged with our Btec Sport programme largely due to the rapport created by the tutors. Good behaviour was rewarded with our REACH reward system and poor choices were challenged. He finished the academic year with an attendance of 85%.

Progression

Riley started at Educ8 and obtained level 2 in maths and English functional skills, Riley took part in our 'Life After School' programme with the support of STARS Charity boating his readiness for employment skills. Riley is now on a college course and applying for jobs.

Retention

Nicole started with us two days per week, she started off very shy but enjoyed being at Educ8. We increased her days to 3 three days. Once year 11's left and a five day placement became available, she started five days and has returned this academic year and is working towards four different qualifications.
