Re: Ofsted Monitoring Report October 2025

Dear Parents and Carers,

We are delighted to share the findings from the latest Ofsted monitoring inspection, which was carried out on **22 October 2025**. The monitoring report clearly highlights the significant improvements the school has made in a relatively short period of time since the initial inspection in **May 2025**. Our response to the inspection report of May 2025 has been robust, particularly around safeguarding, resulting in Ofsted acknowledging that *“The school has put in place an appropriate safeguarding policy that follows current statutory guidance.”*

We are also pleased that *“The admissions register was found to contain all relevant and required information in line with the current statutory guidance. Staff have received training in the use of the correct codes for attendance and absence. This is reflected in the attendance registers, which are completed correctly. The proprietor has ensured that a member of staff now has delegated responsibility for attendance. The school has established effective working relationships with the attendance team at the local authority to ensure that responses to any absences are prompt and appropriate.”*

The report also recognises that the introduction of new management information systems is *“helping the school to protect pupils from harm.”* All staff have received, and will continue to receive, training in these new systems to ensure we continue to build on our recent improvements.

All risk assessments have now been thoroughly reviewed, and the report notes that *“The proprietor and leaders have now put in place a range of suitable risk assessments. They have ensured that these reflect the specific needs of pupils and potential hazards of the school.”* It also acknowledges that *“Staff have received training that helps them to implement these risk assessments effectively.”*
