

Liverpool Learner Outcomes 2024/25

We are proud of the achievements of our learners across vocational and functional skills pathways.

Headline Performance:

- ✓ Overall pass rate: 45.5%
- ✓ FSM learners: 48.0%
- ✓ EHCP learners: 38.7%
- ✓ EAL learners: 50.0%

Subject Strengths:

Hair & Beauty

- 60% overall pass rate (3/5)
- 100% of FSM learners (1/1) achieved the Award

Vocational Studies

- 75% overall pass rate (6/8)
- 100% pass rate for FSM learners (5/5)
- 66.7% pass rate for EHCP learners (2/3)
- 100% pass rate for EAL learners (2/2)

Art and Design

- 85.7% overall pass rate (6/7)
- 100% pass rate for EHCP learners (3/3)
- 100% pass rate for EAL learners (1/1)

Construction

- 20% overall pass rate (1/5)
- One FSM learner achieved 100% (1/1) at Certificate level

Applied Science

- 26.3% overall pass rate (5/19)
- EAL learners achieved 50% (1/2)

Core Skills Success:

Functional Skills English

- 35.3% overall pass rate (6/17)
- 27.3% pass rate for FSM learners (3/11)
- 30.0% pass rate for EHCP learners (3/10)

Functional Skills Maths

- 50% overall pass rate (8/16)

- 36.4% pass rate for FSM learners (4/11)
- 42.9% pass rate for EHCP learners (3/7)
- 50% pass rate for EAL learners (1/2)

What This Means:

- There are clear subject strengths in Vocational Studies and Art & Design, where outcomes exceed 75%.
- FSM learners performed well in Hair and Beauty and Vocational Studies.
- EHCP learners achieved highly in Art & Design (100%).
- Functional Skills outcomes remain weaker overall, with Maths (50%) stronger than English (35.3%).
- Construction and Applied Science outcomes are lower, highlighting areas for focused improvement.
